The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 53.9 in the identified area, compared to 64.3 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current average household income is \$77,734 in this area, compared to \$83,694 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$86,283 in five years, compared to \$96,109 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$32,393 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$31,950. The per capita income is projected to be \$35,912 in five years, compared to \$36,530 for all U.S. households

Currently, 52.8% of the 112,538 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 41.5%, renter occupied; and 5.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 105,453 housing units in the area - 55.6% owner occupied, 37.8% renter occupied, and 6.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.93%. Median home value in the area is \$156,696, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.62% annually to \$178,308.
