Current average household income is \$56,705 in this area, compared to \$83,694 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$63,919 in five years, compared to \$96,109 for all U.S. households

Currently, 44.3% of the 108,290 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 45.5%, renter occupied; and 10.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 102,162 housing units in the area - 48.1% owner occupied, 41.5% renter occupied, and 10.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.62%. Median home value in the area is \$112,262, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.14% annually to \$124,796.
