The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 42.3 in the identified area, compared to 64.3 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 60.6% of the 99,607 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.3%, renter occupied; and 5.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 93,605 housing units in the area - 61.8% owner occupied, 32.1% renter occupied, and 6.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.80%. Median home value in the area is \$176,992, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.18% annually to \$197,185.
