Current per capita income is \$51,041 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$33,028. The per capita income is projected to be \$58,605 in five years, compared to \$36,530 for all U.S. households

Currently, 58.7% of the 3,328 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 26.5%, renter occupied; and 14.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 2,914 housing units in the area - 62.0% owner occupied, 21.6% renter occupied, and 16.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 6.08%. Median home value in the area is \$261,292, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.17% annually to \$290,848.
