Currently, 44.0% of the 114,780 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 46.0%, renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 107,757 housing units in the area - 48.0% owner occupied, 41.7% renter occupied, and 10.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.85%. Median home value in the area is \$122,609, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.27% annually to \$137,176.
