Features large display windows, custom partition walls, updated lighting, hardwood floor. Some basement storage may be available. Nearby public parking. Great pedestrian visibility. \$2,609/mo rent includes \$21.00/sf base rent and \$7.86/sf in pass thru costs.

LOCATION OVERVIEW

Downtown Geneva, on west side of Fox River. The property is on northeast corner of State St. (Route 38) and Third Street, in the heart of downtown commercial area. 9 N Third is in same building as Starbucks and Epic Spa, and is immediately south of Gia Mia restaurant. Close to lots of shopping, restaurants, business services, etc. Just 1/2 mile walk to Metra commuter train station.

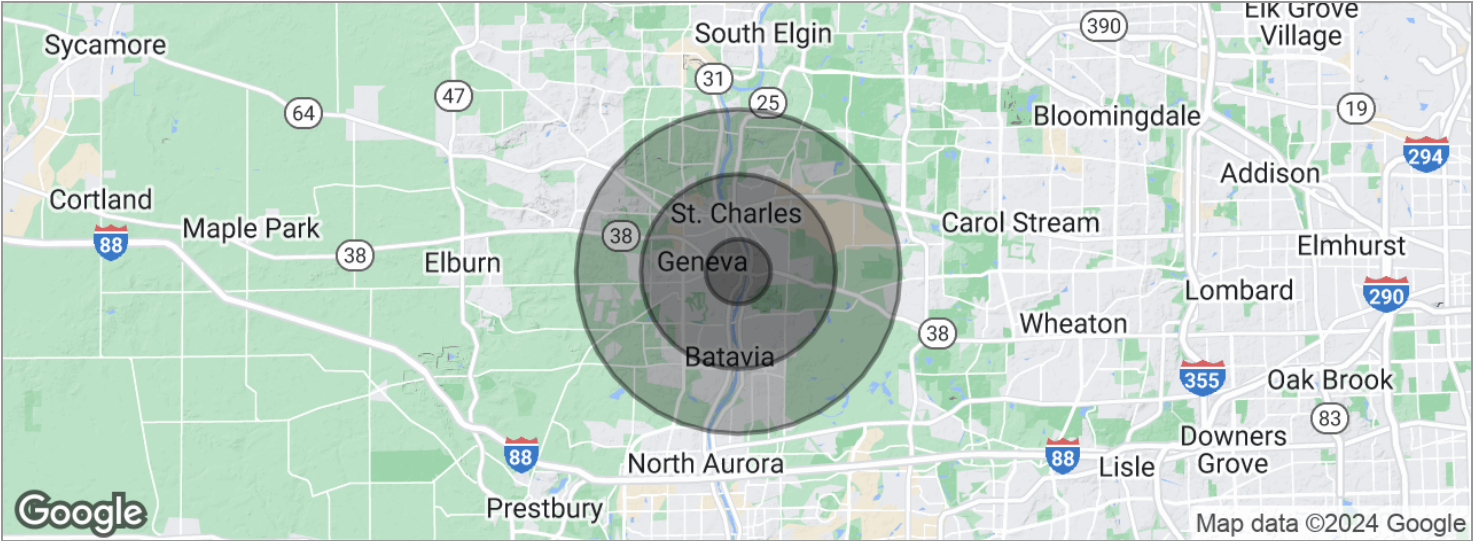

Notable feature is the Fox River. Largest cities are situated along the river - Aurora, Elgin, St Charles, Geneva, Batavia.

The 2030 Land Resource Management Plan divides the county into 3 areas: Urban Corridor - eastern portion, Critical Growth Corridor - middle portion, Agricultural Corridor - western portion.

Thriving commercial base. Farming has long been a way of life and an important economic activity in Kane County. Some farmland has been converted to accommodate increased growth. Official efforts are being made to preserve & protect farmland.

Forest Preserves: Approximately 20,000 acres.
