Deer Creek Campground is a modern Campground with 49 seasonal sites and located on the same parcel of land as Deer Creek Speedway. Just a short walk from your camping site and you will be ready for a night of racing action at Deer Creek Speedway.

All seasonal sites contain water and minimum of 30 amp electrical service to all sites. 20 sites also have 50 amp service available. 13 full hookup sites include sewer hookups.

2 fully remodeled full service bathrooms with showers are available 24 hours per day. 5 acres of primitive camping is available on the grounds for a small nightly fee.

A limited amount of fire rings are available for overnight camping. Wood is available for purchase at the campground office along with Ice in 5lb and 20lb packages.

From the small two-man pup tents to the largest 50' Motorhomes Deer Creek Campground is ready to accommodate all requests. Book your racing and camping vacation now. For those staying at the campground a dump station is available for use as you leave the facility for a small fee.



Luces Off: The Lucas Oil Late Model Series will headline the 2nd Annual North Star Nationals on May 16th. The inaugural event hosted over 3,000 race fans and has quickly become a premier event at the facility. The event will feature the late models running 50 laps with a \$12,000 payday for the feature winner. The series runs 65 events at 37 different tracks across 22 states.

The Lucas Oil Late Model Series will headline the 41st Annual Gopher 50 Charity Late Model Race on July 9th that is co-promoted between Deer Creek Speedway and the Blooming Prairie Lions. In 2019 the event had over 3,000 in attendance which makes the event on of the largest single day events at the speedway.

IMCA Marris Clash: 2019 featured the 28th Annual IMCA Harris Clash. This was the second opportunity for IMCA competitors to turn laps at the prestigious track. In 2020, the Harris Clash once again returns to Deer Creek Speedway for another exciting year as the 29th Annual Harris Clash will be held on Tuesday, August 4th, 2020!

Deer Creek Speedway in 2020. The first stop will come on May 23rd for the Memorial Weekend Spring Challenge and they will return for a second time on September 5th for the Labor Day Duel. Their final three stops will come September 24-26 for the 22nd Annual Fall Jamboree which in 2019 had over 6,500 in attendance, 350 campers and paid out over \$155,000 to the competitors.





BUS Races and Mascot Night, June 13 In 2019 area schools brought their mascots out to Deer Creek Speedway for a fundraising event. they were allowed to pre-sell event tickets for \$13 and received \$6.50 for every ticket sold. There is also many other activities and fundraising throughout the night.

Pink Out, June 20 Pink Out Night is a fundraiser for a local breast cancer support group Join the Journey. In 2019 the event raised over \$10,500.

Fireworks, July 4 Deer Creek Speedway hosts one of the area's largest firework displays following the races making it a great family outing.

Tasseldega Nights, July 18 FREE grandstand admission compliments of your local County Corn Growers Association and local Ag Businesses promoting the use and benefits of Ethanol, brings in the largest crowd annually at Deer Creek. This event is a great hit every year with many activities throughout the day.

Driver Recognition, July 25 Remembering all the great drivers of the past and present by having a pre-race tailgate party and interviewing many drivers and recognizing them throughout the night.

Veteran's Night, August 15 Veteran's Night is a fundraiser for the local Disabled American Veterans Chapter. In 2019 the event raised over \$22,000.


