Current average household income is \$125,452 in this area, compared to \$87,398 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$142,127 in five years, compared to \$99,638 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$49,828 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$33,028. The per capita income is projected to be \$56,482 in five years, compared to \$36,530 for all U.S. households

Currently, 69.2% of the 51,019 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 25.7%, renter occupied; and 5.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 45,865 housing units in the area - 71.5% owner occupied, 22.7% renter occupied, and 5.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.85%. Median home value in the area is \$285,231, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.64% annually to \$309,357.
