
- Property is located on a hard signalized corner and directly off the 210 Freeway with over 251,000 Cars per Day.










REGIONAL MAP

CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO

- The City of San Bernardino is located approximately 60 miles east of Los Angeles, and for more
 than 100 years, it has been a major transportation link between the east and west coasts. With
 rail, freeway, both the San Bernardino International and Ontario International Airports as well as
 the Port of Los Angeles within an hour's drive, San Bernardino is the link to national markets.
- City residents can expect quality, cost effective city services and amenities. The two hospitals within the City limits, Community Hospital of San Bernardino and St. Bernardine's Medical Center are both state of the art facilities. With 35 parks and 11 community centers, residents can enjoy playgrounds, swimming, youth sports, adult sports, senior activities, and special interest classes. The City's menu of programs and services includes a public library system comprised of one main and three library branches which provide life-long learning to the world of ideas, information and creative experience for all citizens of San Bernardino.
- The City of San Bernardino has a population of 216,995 and a labor force of 84,400 with major employers including BNSF Railway Company, California State University San Bernardino, Community Hospital - San Bernardino, the San Bernardino Sheriff Department and the California Department of Transportation.
