1,066 Acres (former nursery) for sale in Gadsden County. Located approximately 2 miles southwest of Downtown Quincy (County Seat of Gadsden County).


The county occupied areas are zoned: AG-1 & AG-2, Agriculture & RR, Rural Residential (County FLU).




