Min. lot size	30,000 sq. ft.
Min. lot width	150 ft.
Building coverage	35%
Setbacks:	
Front yard:	Equal to right-of-way landscape buffer width
Side yard:	20 ft.
Rear yard:	25 ft.
Open Space	30%
Common Open Space	0%

- (17) Fortune tellers, astrologers, and palm readers.
- (18) Furniture and appliance stores.
- (19) Game/recreation facilities.
- (20) Health/exercise clubs.
- (21) Hotels/motels.
