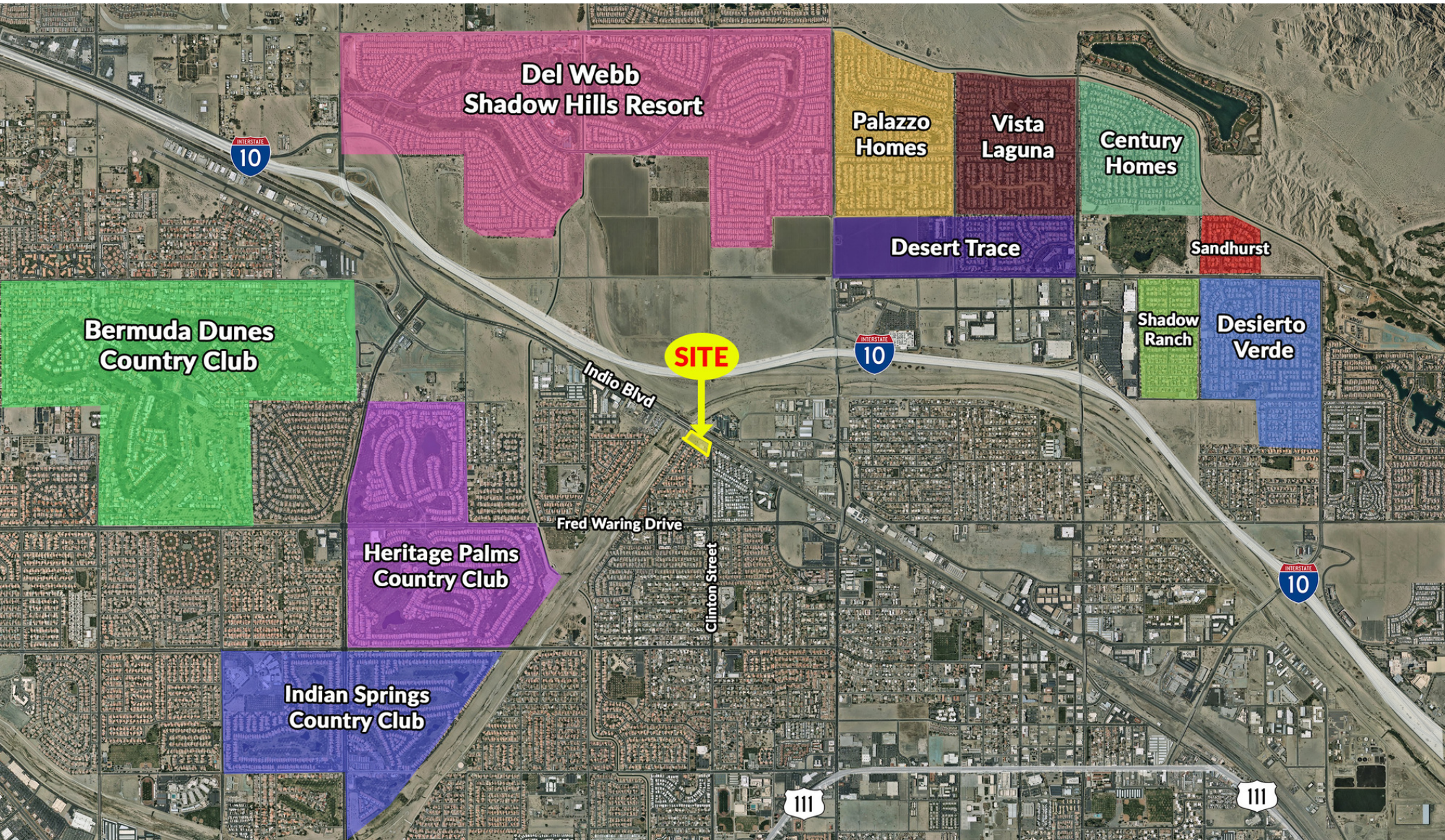

CITY OF INDIO (COACHELLA VALLEY)

- Indio is one of the fastest growing cities in Riverside County with over 85,000 residents, representing a 73% increase since 2000.
- The city of Indio is expecting continued growth and estimates to serve a regional trade area population of 298,000 by 2025.

- Home to the Coachella Valley Music & Arts Festival and Stagecoach Country Music Festival, two of the world’s largest music events.
- Ranked as one of the top emerging travel destinations in the country according to the city website.
- The Indio market features a well-balanced and diverse mix of regional, local, and seasonal residents, international tourists, and highway travelers.
- Indio’s retail and leisure spending exceeded \$1.78 billion in 2013 and is estimated to grow to \$3.3 billion by 2025.
- Indio’s retail, commercial, and hospitality sectors are positioned well to benefit from the continued growth of tourism spending within the Coachella Valley.
