



In the identified area, the current year population is 450,695. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 437,083. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.95% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 476,498 representing a change of 1.12% annually from 2012 to 2017. Currently, the population is 49.5% male and 50.5% female.

The median age in this area is 39.9, compared to U.S. median age of 37.3.

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
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

The household count in this area has changed from 166,293 in 2010 to 171,389 in the current year, a change of 0.93% annually. The five-year projection of households is 180,553, a change of 1.05% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.59, compared to 2.59 in the year 2010. The number of families in the current year is 119,053 in the specified area.

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

Current average household income is \$79,255 in this area, compared to \$68,162 for all U.S households. Average household income is projected to be \$93,842 in five years, compared to \$77,137 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$30,300 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$26,409. The per capita income is projected to be \$35,718 in five years, compared to \$29,882 for all U.S. households

Currently, 64.0% of the 190,541 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 26.0%, renter occupied; and 10.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 11.4% are vacant. In 2010, there were 184,982 housing units in the area - 65.5% owner occupied, 24.4% renter occupied, and 10.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.32%. Median home value in the area is \$183,742, compared to a median home value of \$167,749 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.76% annually to \$220,963.
