
*The combined theatre presence in downtown Aurora has hosted an estimated 320,000 annual patrons in recent years. National studies suggest that approximately 60% of these patrons dine out pre or post theatre event, with 31% dining locally. Limited finer dining restaurant options currently available.




















AURORA ARTS CENTRE - DEVELOPMENT OVERVIEW

City Overview - Aurora, IL


Only 35 miles west of Chicago, the Aurora Area stretches out to parts of Kane, Kendall, Will and DuPage counties and offers savory dining, unique architecture, exciting attractions, a plethora or shopping, and a great variety of family fun and water parks. Aurora is on the edge of the Illinois Technology and Research Corridor and is known as "The City of Lights." Aurora is the second largest city in Illinois with a population of 199,963. Additionally, Aurora features a diversified economy of retail, office, manufacturing, distribution and entertainment industries. In addition to 16 business parks located throughout the city that house various Fortune 500 companies, Aurora is also home to numerous retailers including the Fox Valley regional shopping mall as well as the Chicago Premium Outlets.

Area Business | Education

The city has a long tradition of manufacturing and is home to Caterpillar - one of the two largest Aurora employer at 2,500 employees. Aurora has two hospitals, Rush–Copley Medical Center (2,500 employees) and Presence Mercy Medical Center (1,300 employees). Aurora has three school districts (#129, #131, #204) which are the third, fourth and eighth largest employers in the city. Aurora is home to Aurora University, two branches of Waubonsee Community College, a branch of Rasmussen College and the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy. The active Aurora Public Library offers the community a main library and two branches.

Area Entertainment


Downtown Aurora is home to the Paramount Theatre, a large live performance theater on the National Register of Historic Places, and to the Hollywood Casino. The Hollywood Casino, a dockside gaming facility with 53,000 SF and 1,200 gaming positions, is located on the Fox River. Blackberry Farm, located in Aurora, is a living history museum and offers an indoor/outdoor educational experience for the entire family. Splash Country Water Park is located across from Blackberry Farm and Raging Waves, Illinois' largest water park, is located near Aurora in Yorkville. Phillips Park is also located in Aurora and includes a golf course, zoo an aquatic center.
