

Currently, 70.1% of the 42,687 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 24.8%, renter occupied; and 5.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant.
