In the identified area, the current year population is 54,566. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 44,956. The rate of change since 2010 was 2.71% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 62,158 representing a change of 2.64% annually from 2017 to 2022. Currently, the population is 48.2% male and 51.8% female.

Current median household income is \$49,493 in the area, compared to \$56,124 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$55,274 in five years, compared to \$62,316 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$66,997 in this area, compared to \$80,675 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$76,045 in five years, compared to \$91,585 for all U.S. households

Currently, 47.1% of the 41,482 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 13.0%, renter occupied; and 39.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 35,641 housing units in the area - 45.5% owner occupied, 12.3% renter occupied, and 42.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 6.98%. Median home value in the area is \$214,942, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.39% annually to \$241,918.
