



Currently, 44.9% of the 73,805 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 45.0%, renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant.
