





Your application for a Department of the Army permit received on November 22, 2016, has been assigned the file number SAJ-2016-02997. A review of the information and drawings provided shows the proposed work would result in the placement of fill material over 0.91 acres of waters of the United States (wetlands) for the construction of a commercial development. The project site is located in Section 8, Township 12 South, Range 31 East, Flagler County, Florida.

Your project, as depicted on the enclosed drawings, is authorized by Regional General Permit (GP) SAJ-90, copy enclosed. This authorization is valid until August 15, 2021. You must comply with all of the special and general conditions of the permit; and, any project-specific conditions noted below, or you may be subject to enforcement action. The following project-specific conditions are included with this authorization:

 Within 60 days of completion of the work authorized, the attached "Self-Certification Statement of Compliance" must be completed and submitted to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Mail the completed form to the Regulatory Division, Special Projects and Enforcement Branch, Post Office Box 4970, Jacksonville, Florida 32232-0019. Mitigation Credit Purchase: Within 12 months from the effective date of this
permit, the Permittee shall provide verification to the Corps that 0.91 federal mitigation
bank credits have been purchased from the Lake Swamp Mitigation Bank. The required
verification shall reference this project's permit number (SAJ-2016-02997).

Generally, authorization of activities that have commenced or are under contract to commence in reliance of the GP will remain in effect provided the activity is completed within 12 months of the date a GP expired or was revoked. In the event you have not completed construction of your project within the specified time limit, a separate application or re-verification will likely be required.
