The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 26.0 in the identified area, compared to 64.3 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$104,075 in the area, compared to \$58,100 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$109,073 in five years, compared to \$65,727 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$128,486 in this area, compared to \$83,694 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$138,981 in five years, compared to \$96,109 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$45,915 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$31,950. The per capita income is projected to be \$49,462 in five years, compared to \$36,530 for all U.S. households

Currently, 77.0% of the 35,344 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 20.2%, renter occupied; and 2.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 29,480 housing units in the area - 78.2% owner occupied, 16.7% renter occupied, and 5.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 8.40%. Median home value in the area is \$251,275, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.42% annually to \$283,141.
